14 **JUDGMENT**

15 THIS MATTER came on regularly before the undersigned judge of the above-entitled  
 16 Court. Plaintiff, STATE OF WASHINGTON (STATE), appearing through its attorneys of  
 17 record, ROBERT W. FERGUSON, Attorney General, S. TODD SIPE, Assistant Attorney  
 18 General, PAUL M. CRISALLI, Assistant Attorney General. Defendants TIMOTHY DONALD  
 19 EYMAN, individually; TOUGHER TO RAISE TAXES – VWMC, a political committee;  
 20 BRING BACK OUR \$30 CAR TABS, a political committee; 2/3RDS-FOR-TAXES  
 21 CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT; a political committee; WE LOVE OUR CARS – VWMC  
 22 – 2017, a political committee, were represented by Mark Lamb, but who did not appear on this  
 23 motion. Defendants BARBARA SMITH, MIKE FAGAN, and JACK FAGAN appeared by  
 24 attorney of record, Mark Lamb. The Court, having reviewed the records and files herein, and  
 25 having granted the State’s Motion for Default Judgment, and being otherwise fully advised in  
 26 the premises, it is hereby **ORDERED** as follows:

1. Defendant TOUGHER TO RAISE TAXES - VWMC, a political committee, is hereby  
 assessed a civil penalty, under the provisions of RCW 42.17A.750, in the amount of  
 \$2,910.00 payable to the State of Washington within 30 days of the entry of this Judgment.

- 1 2. Defendant BRING BACK OUR \$30 CAR TABS, a political committee, is hereby assessed  
2 a civil penalty, under the provisions of RCW 42.17A.750, in the amount of \$7,700.00  
3 payable to the State of Washington within 30 days of the entry of this Judgment.
- 4 3. Defendant 2/3RDS-FOR-TAXES CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT, a political  
5 committee, is hereby assessed a civil penalty, under the provisions of RCW 42.17A.750, in  
6 the amount of \$6,640.00 payable to the State of Washington within 30 days of the entry of  
7 this Judgment.
- 8 4. Defendant WE LOVE OUR CARS – VWMC - 2017, a political committee, is hereby  
9 assessed a civil penalty, under the provisions of RCW 42.17A.750, in the amount of  
10 \$5,090.00 payable to the State of Washington within 30 days of the entry of this Judgment.
- 11 5. Defendant TIMOTHY DONALD EYMAN, individually, is hereby assessed a civil penalty,  
12 under the provisions of RCW 42.17A.750, in the amount of \$22,340.00 payable to the State  
13 of Washington within 30 days of the entry of this Judgment or such other time as determined  
14 by the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Washington in *In re Eyman*,  
15 Dckt. No. 18-14536.
- 16 6. At the discretion of the Court, as authorized under RCW 42.17A.780, Defendant TIMOTHY  
17 DONALD EYMAN, individually, shall pay to the State of Washington the amount of  
18 \$17,827.28 as reasonable attorneys' fees and \$366.25 as court costs within 30 days of this  
19 Judgment.
- 20 7. Consistent with CR 54(b), the Court determines and directs that this judgment be entered as  
21 a final judgment as to the following defendants: TOUGHER TO RAISE TAXES – VWMC,  
22 a political committee; BRING BACK OUR \$30 CAR TABS, a political committee; 2/3RDS-  
23 FOR-TAXES CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT; a political committee; WE LOVE  
24 OUR CARS – VWMC – 2017, a political committee; and TIMOTHY DONALD EYMAN,  
25 individually. The Court directs the entry of such judgment because there is no just reason for  
26 delay. The Court finds that the remaining issues that need to be decided as to the remaining

1 defendants can easily be decided separately, and there is nothing that would prevent the entry  
2 of separate judgments as to those defendants. The Court finds that the interests of judicial  
3 economy weigh towards entering a final judgment as to these Defendants.
